## ABOUT OUR TRAILS

The Highlands Plateau Greenway is made up of a network of community trails, side-walks and gravel roads that allow users to see the Plateau's natural beauty up close. While the community has over 5 miles of greenway, this map provides a kid-friendly itinerary of routes that are only on pedestrian designated trails.



## THE CHALLENGE

On every trail labeled in purple on this map, there is a stamping station that must be found. This station will be a mail box painted purple and will be located on the trail. Within the mailbox there will be a stamp that must be placed over the corresponding stamp on the map-side of this passport.
